Students explore Performing Arts, Technologies, Italian, and Physical Education, giving them the chance to be creative, solve problems, stay active, and expand their world. Whether they're on stage, designing and building in Technologies, learning a new language, or playing sport, every experience helps prepare them for the future.

Wellbeing at the Heart of Learning

As a Positive Education school, we explicitly teach resilience, confidence, and emotional intelligence. Through Wellbeing Days, mindfulness activities, strong pastoral care, and trauma-informed practices, we ensure students feel supported in and out of the classroom. A dedicated Wellbeing Leader and allied health professionals work closely with teachers to provide the right support when it's needed, with targeted interventions for students requiring additional assistance, including neurodiverse learners.
