Your Involvement

We are blessed to be a school that is made up of many different cultures, languages and faiths. As parents, your involvement in the school and your child's education is vital in supporting all to continue to flourish. There are two formal ways in which parents can actively contribute in this way, the School Board and Parents and Friends Committee. In the coming weeks, both groups will be seeking nominations from our parent community to join them.

School Board

Nominations are now open for four (4) available positions as Parent Representatives on the School Board. The School Board is an advisory Board supporting the Leadership of the school ensuring that the strategic direction and financial responsibilities are being met. As we come in to 2023, the School Board will be engaging in two very important processes. Firstly, the implementation of a new Strategic Plan as mentioned earlier. The second, the development of a new Master Plan for TWCS – this is a process of reviewing our current physical buildings and spaces and developing a plan for future building developments.

The School Board meets twice a term in the evening throughout the school year.

Parents and Friends Committee

This week we held our first Parents and Friends Committee meeting. It is a wonderful opportunity for families to be involved in supporting community events, fundraising opportunities and just bringing people together.

At our meeting we formally thanked outgoing Chairperson Jess Rainsford and Secretary Kirsty Miller for the massive effort they both have committed to our school community over the past 2 years. Challenged with COVID in 2021/2022, both Jess and Kirsty were able to continue to organise and provide community events and support for school events such as Shrove Tuesday pancakes, BBQ lunches,

Ice-Creams at lunch time, the list goes on. On behalf of the entire community, I would like to publicly thank both Jess and Kirsty for their dedication to TWCS.

At the end of the meeting we were able to formally accept nominations for these roles for 2023/2024. It is with great pleasure that I announce Chris Trewin as Chairperson and Jane O'Donoghue as Secretary. We have lots of new and creative ideas that we look forward to engage everyone in throughout this year. The next meeting is in Week 7 – it would be great to see as many people there as possible.

Learning and Wellbeing

At Tenison Woods, we believe that a child's wellbeing is equally as important as their academic development. If a child does not have a balanced wellbeing, then their ability to engage in new learning is limited. In 2023, we will be continuing with this commitment through resourcing Courtney Quigley as our Wellbeing Leader and Karlee Cave and Gaby Barendreght as Allied Health professionals working with children, families and staff to ensure we are continuing to lead the way in wellbeing practices in schools.

Hand in hand with our commitment to the wellbeing of all, is our commitment we make to each child and their families about their academic progress. We are continuing to refine our literacy and intervention practices this year as we further embed research-based best practices in literacy. We have also established an intervention program for children with English as a secondary language and a gross motor skills program for the Junior Primary classes. As educators, we will be using 2023 to research and trial best practices in mathematics for Reception to Yr 6, ensuring consistency of practice is evident in each class.

Finally, what a difference a year makes. In Feb 2022, we were navigating a new situation for schools dealing with COVID, learning from home and only having a small number of children at school. Fast forward 12months, and we have a courtyard full of people, meeting each other for the first time and making friendships that will last a lifetime. I would like to say a very sincere 'Thank You' to each one of you for the wonderful way in which you advocate for your children, for the way you support both them and the school in ensuring we have a community and school that brings a smile to everyone's face.



Religious Identity and Mission



This school badge is in use at all St Joseph's schools and was designed by Sr Fergus Brosnahan in 1926. It is from this crest that we take our school motto.

The Latin words 'In Omnibus Caritas' have sometimes been replaced by the English translation: 'In all things Love' or 'Love in Everything'.

Mary MacKillop's words, written to the Sisters a few months before her death, were the inspiration for this motto:

"Do not be afraid. Love one another, bear with one another and let charity (love) guide you in all your life." (MMK - January 12, 1909)

The Season of LENT - Feb 22nd - April 9th

Shrove Tuesday is the day before Ash Wednesday and is a time to reflect on the last 12 months and to attend Reconciliation (or Confession) as we prepare for the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus. It is also a time used to clear the pantry and fridge of any extra food and to prepare for the giving up of particular foods for Lent. Pancakes are the perfect meal to use up the supply of milk, butter and eggs.

Each year, Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent and is always 46 days before Easter Sunday. Lent is a 40-day season (not

counting Sundays) marked by repentance, fasting, reflection, and ultimately celebration.

Lent asks Catholics and those of goodwill to set aside a time each year to give to others in the form of service or to give up matters in the material world to give space for reflection and others. This marks a focus on Christ's life, ministry, sacrifice, and resurrection.


